

## World Albatross Day Word Scramble

Find the **HIGHLIGHTED** words in the box below.

The ALBATROSS is an amazing SEABIRD that is able to roam across the world's oceans. Unfortunately, albatrosses are facing a conservation CRISIS. On land the species are impacted by PESTS including CATS, RATS and MICE that prey on both the nesting parents and their young, as well as introduced PLANTS that overgrow breeding colonies. The breeding colonies are also threatened by CLIMATE CHANGE, particularly EROSION of near shore habitats due to SEA LEVEL RISE. While at sea albatrosses are at risk of being caught in fishing gear. This includes being hooked by LONGLINES, which set hundreds, to thousands of baited hooks that attract seabirds including albatrosses, and being entangled in TRAWL nets and GILLNETS leading to the birds drowning. Albatrosses are also disoriented by DECK LIGHTING with birds crashing into vessels at night and then unable to fly away. If all these conservation threats were not enough, albatrosses are also impacted by POLLUTION on land and at sea, with many albatrosses now being found dead having ingested PLASTICS.
